

4C | Court-Ordered Volunteer Program**Revised:** 6/12/19

The Library accepts applications for court-ordered community service hours from residents of the Roselle Public Library District working with the court systems of Cook and DuPage Counties. A maximum of twelve (12) hours will be allotted per applicant. All requests are subject to availability of projects or tasks to be accomplished as well as availability of Library staff to train and directly supervise court-ordered volunteers.

Court-ordered volunteer applicants who have been convicted of crimes involving personal injury or threat of injury, theft, or any similar offense will not be accepted into this volunteer program. Pre-approval must be granted by the supervising staff member or department manager, and the Executive Director.

Volunteers in this program are required to adhere to all Library policies and procedures and are expected to conform to their set schedule and time commitment. Non-adherence will result in cancellation of the volunteer's participation.
