Programs and events are a vital service provided by the Library to the Roselle community, providing informational, educational, and entertainment opportunities to participants in alignment with the Library's mission and strategic goals; as well as opportunities to showcase the collections, services, and equipment available at the Library.

Guidelines

In most cases, all programs and events held by the Library shall be free. Exceptions to this include programs requiring some form of supply or certification fee, from which the Library shall not profit, as well as fundraising events hosted by the Library or a fundraising group on behalf of the Library.

In general, programs will not be held that seek to sell products or services directly to attendees; though individuals or organizations presenting at the behest of the Library may be allowed to advertise their services.
