

8G | Displays and Exhibits**Revised:** 4/10/19**Purpose**

The Library shall make limited spaces available for displays and exhibits, including: collections, posters, artworks, literature, etc.; created or curated by Library personnel, as well as individuals and outside organizations for informational, educational and entertainment purposes.

Guidelines

All displays and exhibits are to be approved by the Executive Director or their designated staff member. Displays and exhibits from commercial or profit-making organizations shall not be permitted, except by the express approval of the Executive Director.

Unauthorized displays or exhibits will be promptly removed and disposed of.

Displays and exhibits which advocate the election or defeat of a candidate for public office, or which advocate an affirmative or negative vote on any proposition, political or otherwise, or which specifically solicit membership for political or religious organizations shall not be permitted.

The Library assumes no responsibility for the preservation, protection, or possible damage to, or theft of, any item or artwork displayed on Library premises. All items placed on display at the Library are done so at the owner's risk.

Storage on any short- or long-term basis for display or exhibit items will not be made available to outside exhibitors.
