

9C | 3D Printing**Adopted:** 1/9/19**Purpose**

The Library offers the use of a 3D printer to all library users in good standing to create three-dimensional objects. Use of a 3D printer will be modelled after other types of equipment and materials currently available for use at the Library.

Guidelines

Patrons will not be permitted to use any Library equipment, including the 3D printer, to create objects that are:

1. Prohibited by local, state, or federal law
2. Unsafe, harmful, dangerous, or pose a threat to the well-being of others
3. Are sexually explicit, obscene, or inappropriate for a library setting
4. In violation of the terms of use of the manufacturer of the equipment
5. In violation of anyone's intellectual property rights or otherwise under copyright
6. In violation of any other Library policy or procedure
7. For commercial use

The Library reserves the right to:

1. Refuse any request
2. Stop the project due to time or equipment capabilities
3. Set a limit as to the maximum amount of time a project may take
4. Limit the number of requests

Only designated, trained Library staff will operate the Library's 3D printer(s).
